*In order to be eligible to enter, participants must have a USCA scorebook or USCA-certified scorebook, or post \$50 scorebook bond (if a USCA member) which will be sent to the USCA office with the trial results. Entry will not be accepted without proof of such scorebook or additional \$50 bond included with entry fee. The scorebook bond will be refunded if the necessary paperwork for the issuance of a USCA scorebook or for certification of the foreign scorebook is received by the USCA office within ten days of the trial. Canadian participants may use their Canadian scorebooks, provided a photocopy of the scorebook (including identification page) is given to the trial secretary for submittal with the trial results.
